

# Free School Meal Eligibility

If you would like to check if you are entitled to Free School Meals for your children we now have access to an on-line Free School Meal eligibility check.

The checker is easy to use and completely confidential, simply click on the link below which takes you through to a short questionnaire and you will receive a decision immediately. The school will then be informed of the outcome.

Benefits are:-

A free school meal for your child.

Savings for you - worth over £350 a year.

Extra money for the school through Pupil Premium - worth £1385 a year.

Remember just registering your child for Free School Meals means that school receives the extra money even if you don't take up the free meal.

No-one will know that you have registered and it will not affect any other benefits you are claiming.
